

Regional Energy Coaches PILOT PROGRAM

Are you an affordable housing provider looking to make your existing units or new builds more energy-efficient?

The Regional Energy Coaches (REC) pilot project can help! The Federation of Canadian Municipalities has teamed up with the Community Housing Transformation Centre, BC Non-Profit Housing Association, and the Co-operative Housing Federation of Canada to support this new initiative.

Regional Energy Coaches offer one-on-one coaching and support to affordable housing providers (i.e. non-profit organizations and co-operatives) of **any size** with projects at **any stage**. They can help you plan and start energy-efficient retrofits and new construction while reducing utility costs.

What kind of help can Regional Energy Coaches offer your organization?



Virtual walk-through energy assessments to identify and evaluate opportunities for energy retrofits;



Advice on how to incorporate energy-efficiency opportunities into other planned repairs and maintenance;



Assistance to identify appropriate resources, funding and financing opportunities during your planning process;



Inform the development of a business case for energy efficiency, with next steps outlined;



Support with preparing an application for funding from FCM's Green Municipal Fund's Sustainable Affordable Housing (SAH) initiative.












How does the process of getting help work?
